- Bullying will not be tolerated.

Failure to do any of the above will result in :

- Being asked to get out of the water for a 'cooling off' period.
- Being asked to dress and leave the premises.
- Suspension for a given period

Parents and Spectators

We are all responsible for setting a good example to other members of LSC, particular to the youngsters.

- Allow the Volunteers in charge on poolside to do their work without interference.
- Accept their decisions without shouting or arguing with them. If there are any issues you wish to discuss, please raise them at the end of a session. Discussions during the session put the other children at risk.
- Treat all volunteers with respect and courtesy.
